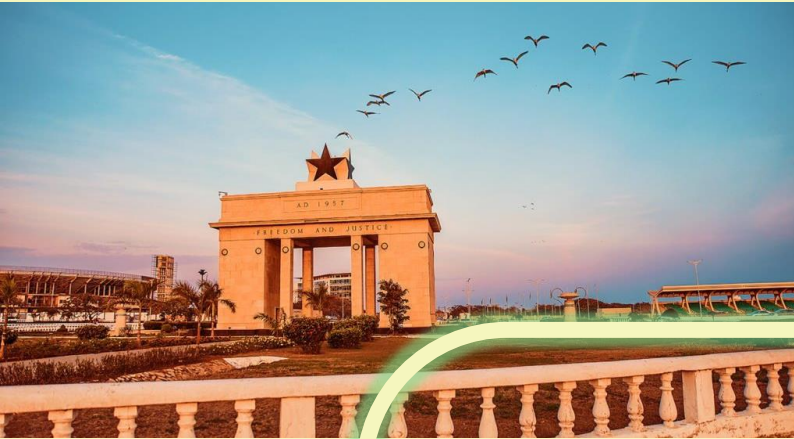

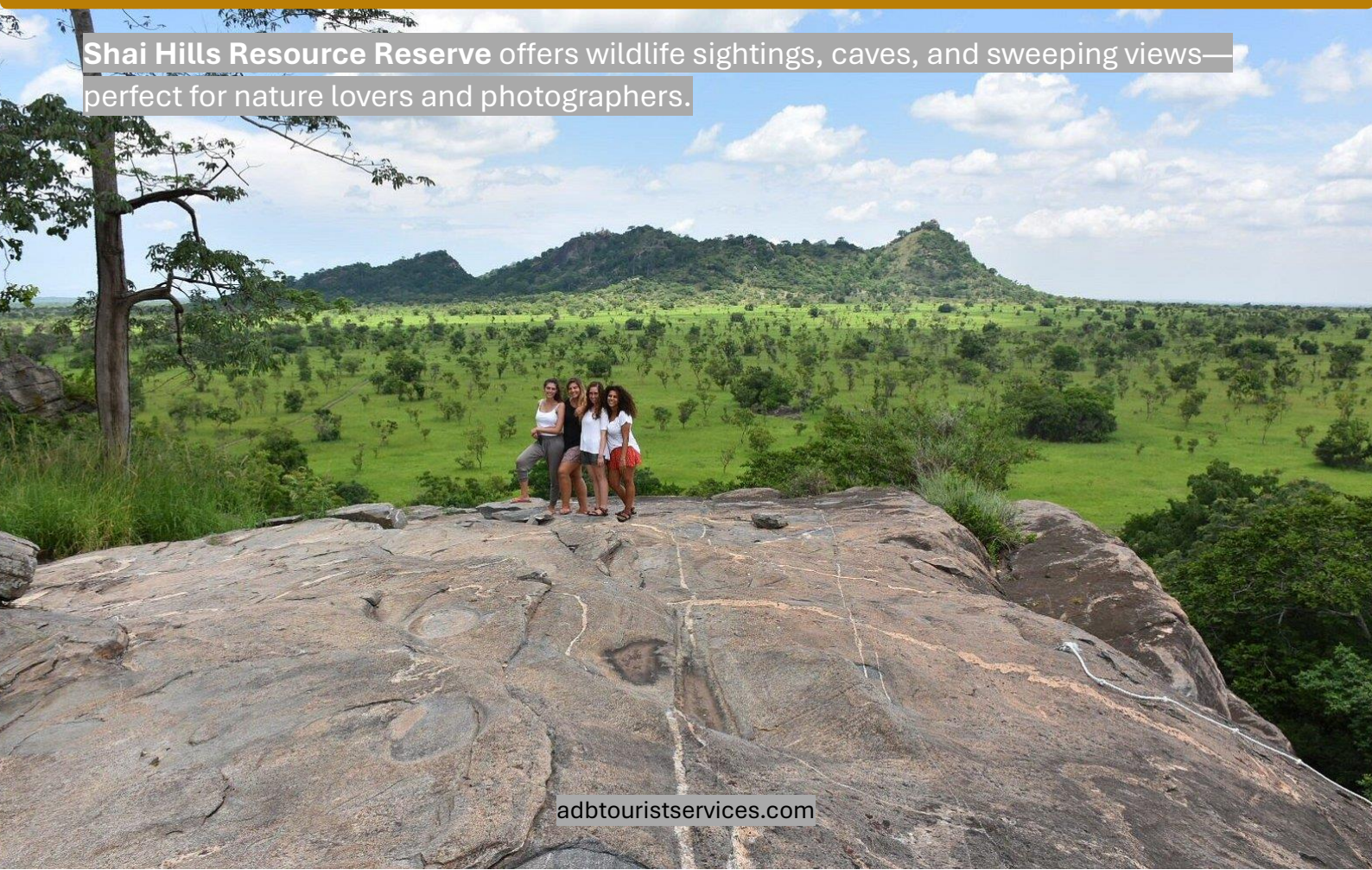

Akosombo's impressive dam walls to boat rides and serene views of the lake. It's both educational and relaxing, perfect for those seeking a balance of nature and innovation.

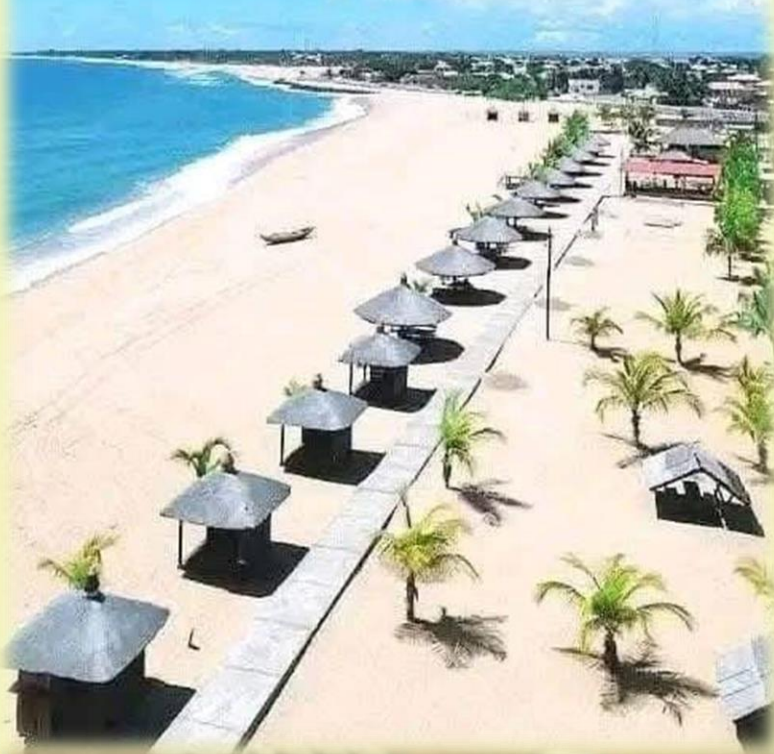

(often based on their birth day/gender) Performed by elders, involving rituals like pouring libations, blessings, music, dancing, and feasting, symbolizing reconnection with your ancestors.

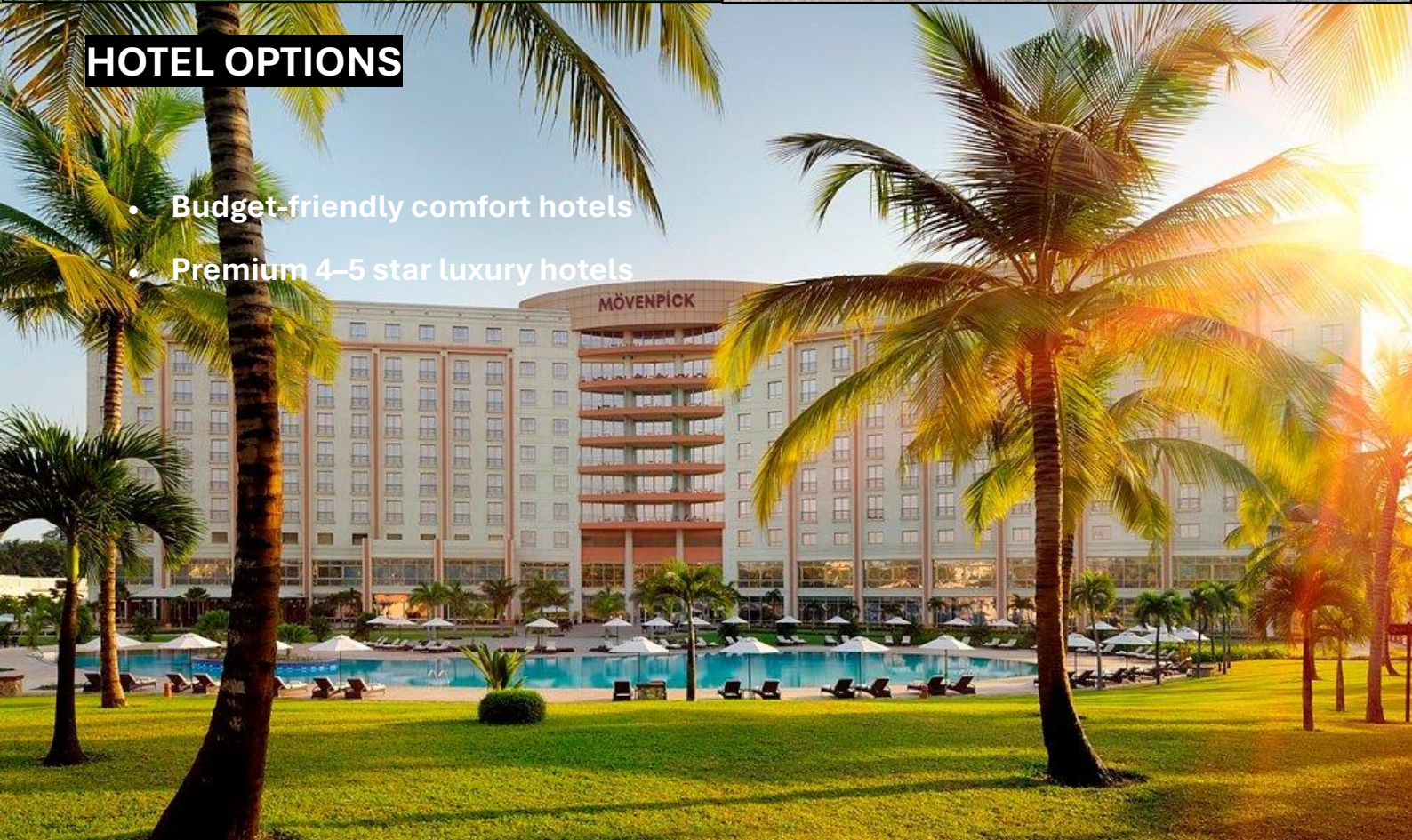
